There are also occasional social events, usually near Christmas and mid-summer, together with informal summer visits to churches and places of historic and heraldic interest. The Society is a corporate member of The Heraldry Society and of the Federation of Norfolk Historical and Archaeological Organisations. As such it is a contributor to the activities of these bodies and also holds occasional exhibitions of heraldic material in its own right to encourage further research and interest in the subject.

The Society's Journal, *Norfolk Heraldry*, is published occasionally and the newsletter *The Norfolk Standard* is issued three times a year. Those joining mid-year will receive the three issues for that calendar year.
